NATIONAL AGREEMENT

On May 28, 2009 we had an International Rep, Steve Raich, come to the union hall and give a roll out on the revised National Agreement. The agreement passed 74% to 26% for both skilled trades and production.

On June 8 and 9, 2009 we had roll out meetings in the plant on the new Special Attrition Packages (SAP). These meetings were for active and laid off employees. Please remember that when you are making this life altering decision, that you don't make the decision on the spur of the moment. It is important to discuss everything with family members and a financial advisor.

LAYOFFS

Make sure that you stop by the Transitional Center in the plant before being laid off. The Benefits office has been providing us with current information and updates regarding layoffs.

JULY SHUTDOWN

The July shutdown will be June 29 – July 10, 2009. We have new language for this shut down period. We are receiving Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) memos from the International and Center for Human Resources as current as June 4, 2009. When we have the final interpretations, we will report it out to you.

PARAGRAPH 96 MOVES

We have received information from the International informing us that Mansfield and Springhill moves are dead in the water (not gonna happen). The other moves to Flint and Marion have been delayed temporarily due to the attrition packages. Stay tuned to the Local 730, UAW website in July (after the shut down) for further updates.

FLINT TDO – DIEMAKERS

It is very important to make sure you have signed up through the NEPC (1-800-NAT-HIRE) System for Appendix A moves. The Cisco Code for plant 38 is 31031.
