Davis Vision Eye Exam Facts

Exam with an Optometrist

Use Davis Vision Participating providers for an eye exam at no cost. (Except for a fitting fee for contact lenses at some locations.) Choose frames from a provider who carries the Exclusive Frame Collection such as Rx Optical, Smeelink, Kent Optical, Eye and ENT Specialists, Integrity Eyewear and others to get the best use of your benefits. Find participating providers near you at www.davisvision.com.

Exam with Ophthalmologist – MD

This is a medical examination of your eyes. Most Ophthalmologists do not participate with Davis Vision. You can still use your exam benefit through the Out of Network Claim system. Benefits are reimbursed to you for the reasonable and customary amount, minus a \$7 co-pay. A claim form must be filled out and sent to Davis Vision along with a copy of the itemized bill. If Medicare and Blue Cross Blue Shield are billed, Davis Vision will require a copy of the Explanation of Benefits page as well. Dependent Eligibility for Health Care Changes

Effective January 1, 2009, after turning age 19, children must be full-time students for at least one full school term during the calendar year to stay eligible for GM health care coverage. Full-time students may stay on the health care coverage until the end of the year they turn 24. These age requirements do not apply to children who have been approved as totally and permanently disabled. Court ordered medical support documents no longer provide eligibility without full-time student status after age 19.

Healthcare Audit

For those with dependents, did you respond to the audit package you received and have you received a confirmation? If you do not respond to this audit by February 13, 2009, any eligible dependents will be terminated as of March, 1, 2009. If you have questions about the audit process, call 1-888-898-1101. Remember, dependents not on healthcare are not covered by Dependent Life Insurance
